Why Sheboygan County's Children Need Help Building Early Literacy Skills

A Crisis in Early Literacy: The Need is Urgent

When You Can't Afford the Essentials, Books are a Luxury

• In Sheboygan's 53081 ZIP code, 39% of households are "below the ALICE threshold"* and struggling to afford basic needs like food, housing, child care and medicine. For these families, purchasing books simply isn't possible.



Sheboygan is a Book Desert

Research shows that children need access to at least 100 books in the home in their early years to set the
foundation for school success. Yet for many families in Sheboygan County, that milestone is far out of reach.
Our community has "below average" access to affordable books, making it a "book desert"* where too many
children grow up without a home library.



3rd Graders Struggle to Read

Within the 53081 ZIP code, 60% of 3rd graders read below grade level, compared to 47% statewide.*** Third
grade reading proficiency is a critical predictor of high school graduation rates. Without intervention, these
gaps compound over time, limiting future opportunities.

The Solution: Dolly Parton's Imagination Library

The Imagination Library provides children with a high-quality, age-appropriate book every month from birth to age five, mailed directly to their home. This program is offered at no charge to the parents or caregivers.



- Cost-Effective & Scalable: For less than \$3 per child per month, the program ensures equitable access to books at a scale that no single family or school district could achieve alone.

- Focusing on Greatest Need: By first launching this program in Sheboygan's 53081 ZIP code, the area with the highest rates of ALICE households and struggling readers, United Way of Sheboygan County will be addressing the most urgent need first. The direct mailing model helps eliminate transportation and scheduling barriers.



Proven Impact: Studies show the program improves early literacy, strengthens family
reading habits and helps children enter kindergarten better prepared. 97% of parents
believe that their child will be better prepared for school after having participated in the
Imagination Library.
